What: What are the challenges and the future of the power sector and how can the energy trilemma be solved?

Stefan-Alexandru Frangulea has graduated BA and MSc with the Academy of Economic Studies from Bucharest, specializing in Financial and Capital Markets. He also graduated the EMBA Program delivered by the IEDC Bled School of Management in 2006 and the Romanian EMBA Program developed by WU Vienna University in 2008. From graduation until 2007, Stefan worked in Corporate Banking with several financial institutions like Citibank, Raiffeisen, HVB/UniCredit working with major corporate names of the country and being involved in the structuring teams for several landmark transactions. From 2007 to 2011 he joined General Electric (GE) first as a VP for Customer Financing in South East-Europe region and then as Treasurer of GE Money's Financial Non-Banking Institutions. From 2011 to 2013 he was part of the team of BCR (Erste Group) first as Head of Public Sector and then as Sales Management Director of the pension fund subsidiary BCR Pensii. Between 2012-2016 he was also Member of the Board of Administration for the national company "Administration of Navigable Canals" and since 2014 he had several positions in the Strategy area of the electricity producer Hidroelectrica S.A., including responsibilities regarding the future IPO. Starting with January 2015, Frangulea is President of the Romanian Association of Treasurers.
