Career

Iulia Jianu (1978) is a professor of Accounting (specializations: financial accounting, managerial accounting and tax accounting), Vice Dean of Bucharest Business School and Director of the Romanian-French INDE MBA programme at the Bucharest University of Economic Studies (ASE). She is also Program Manager Romania of the European Postmaster Accountancy programme at Tilburg University. She obtained the professional qualification of certified public accountant at the Body of Expert and Licensed Accountants of Romania (CECCAR) in 2007. She wrote her dissertation "Accounting theory and financial reporting regarding the company's performance" in 2006 at ASE. He graduated from the Controlling and Finance European master programme at University of Orleans in 2003, from the Decision and Management Control in Accounting master programme at ASE in 2001, and from the Accounting and Management Information Systems bachelor programme of the same university in 2000. She was involved in many research projects gained by competition and financed by National Research Council, first as a member of the research team and further as project manager. She has Romanian and international publication – including 25 books as author and co-author, 70 scientific and professional articles and more than 60 research studies presented at international conferences. Iulia Jianu is a member of the editorial board of the Journal of Accounting and Management Information Systems (JAMIS), and a member of the organizing committee of AMIS International Conference. From 2005 till 2010 she was the Vice Director of the Accounting and Audit master programme organized by the National Institute of Economic and Accounting Technics of the CNAM (Paris) in cooperation with the Faculty of Accounting and Management Information Systems of the ASE (Bucharest). She is an active member of CECCAR, as lecturer, expert in accounting consultancy, and member of the Working Group on Legislation in taxation and accounting. Iulia regularly is involved in continuing education activities for professionals from various companies and institutions, being regularly invited for consultancy assignments in financial and tax accounting.
